Postgraduate Award of Proficiency in Assessment for Access Arrangements

“Access Arrangements Assessors must have successfully completed a postgraduate (level 7) course with at least 100 hours relating to individual assessment.”

JCQ regulations

The PAPAA, offered by Include-ed, in association with Communicate-ed, meets the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) criteria for professionals assessing for access arrangements in general qualifications. This qualification is at the equivalent of Level 7 on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF). The PAPAA takes approximately 115 to 120 hours to complete, depending on previous knowledge and experience.

The course is split into 2 units:

Unit 1: Understanding the Principles of Psychometric Testing

- *An introduction to the principles of educational testing*
- *How to administer a range of appropriate standardised tests*

Unit 2: Assessing for Access Arrangements

- *Understanding the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) regulations*
- *Applying the regulations within your centre*
